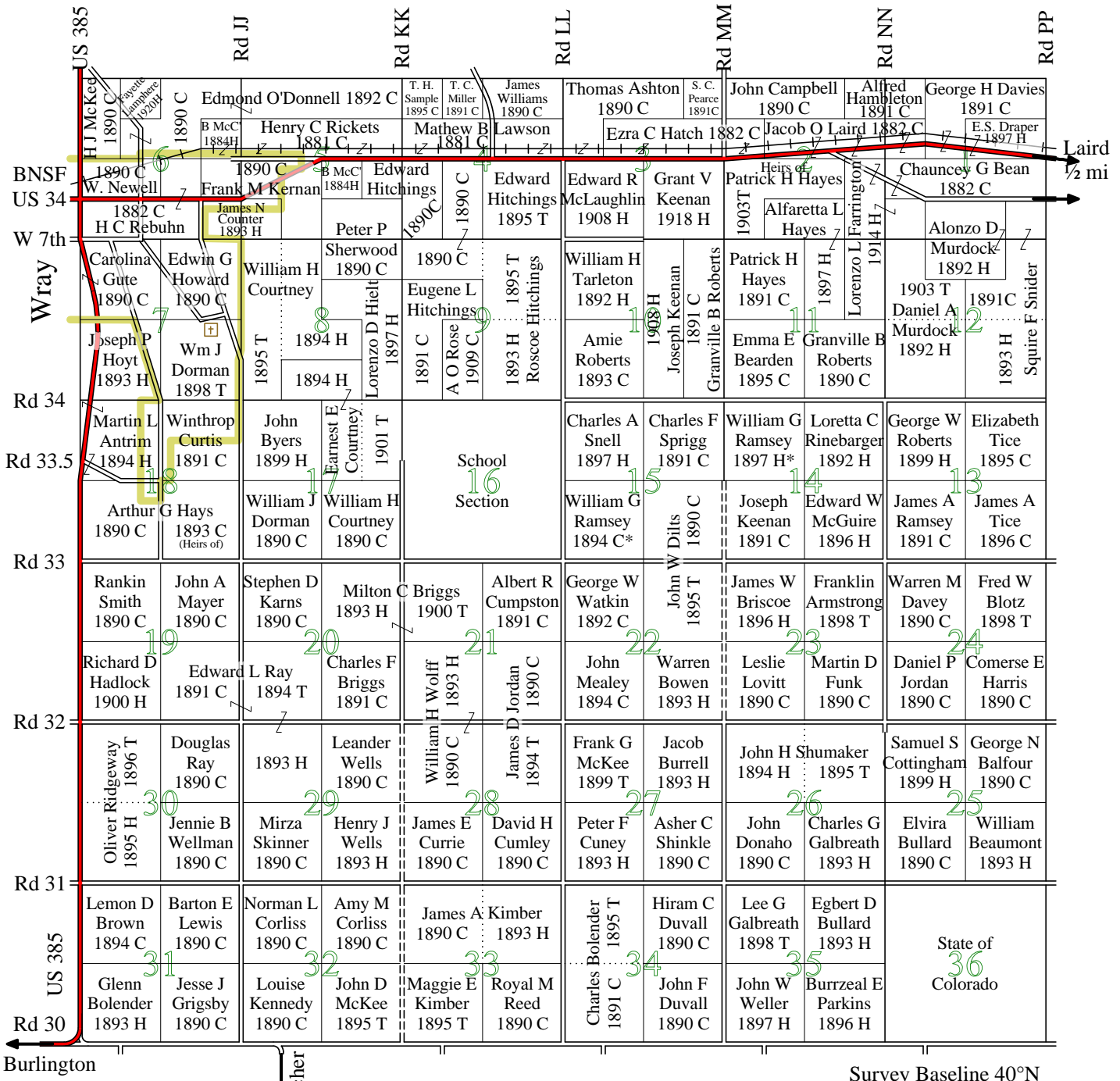


Yellow line is Wray city limits.

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Notes:

1. The BLM database shows the southeast quarter of section 18 transferred to both William R. Hays and the Heirs of Arthur G. Hays but doesn't provide a patent image to clarify matters. This map shows only the Arthur G. Hays patent.

2. The database shows two "Homestead Act" patents issued to William G. Ramsey; the first in 1894 for the southwest quarter of section 15 and the second in 1897 for the northwest quarter of section 14. Clearly one of them is coded incorrectly and should instead be a cash sale or timber culture. W.G. Ramsey arrived in the area in 1890. Since the 1894 patent is too soon after his arrival for a five year "Homestead Patent" residence that one must have been a "Cash Sale" and is shown that way.
