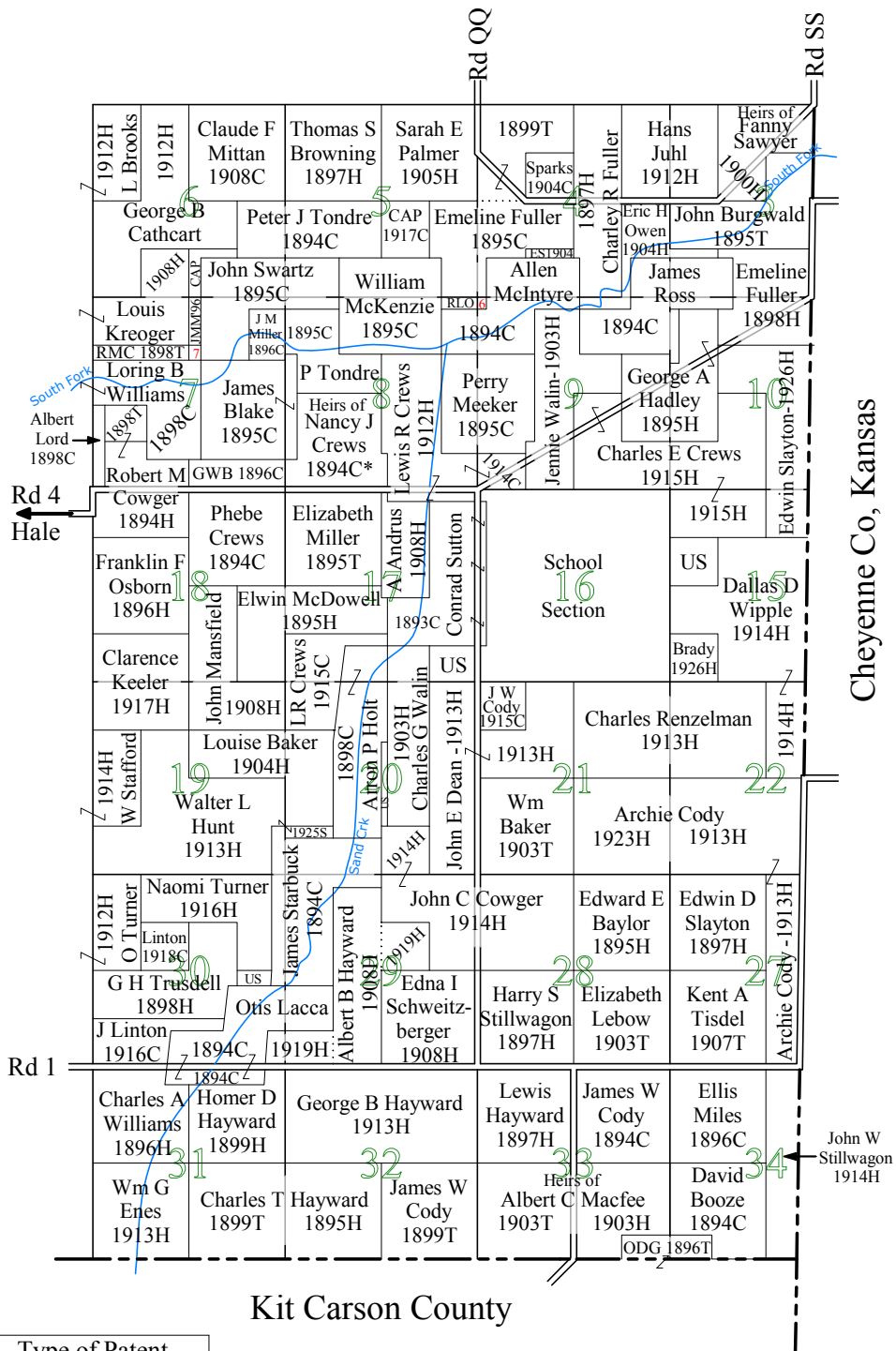


Township 5 South Range 42 West Yuma County, Colorado

'Wililam' Baker spelling is from the BLM database.

George Broadsword's 1896 cash sale patent (sec 7) in the database includes a 1.5 acre lot, marked with a red "7" on the map, a half-mile north of the other 64 acres described.

Robert Cowger's 1898 timber culture patent (sec 7) was shown in the database as two plots (21 acres and 29 acres) north and south of the river. The smaller one is marked "RMC 1898T" on the map.

The 'Heirs of Nancy J Crews' July 1894 cash sale patent (sec 8) in the database also has her son, William Crews, listed.

John Miller's 1896 cash sale patent (sec 7) was in two plots. The smaller western one is marked "JMM'96" on the map.

Charles A Puderbaugh's 14 acres in section 6 was acquired under an Aug 1915 cash sale patent.

Eugene V Sparks' 1904 cash sale patent included three separate lots totaling 54 acres. They are marked "Sparks 1904C" and "ES 1904" in section 4 and with a red "6" in section 9.
