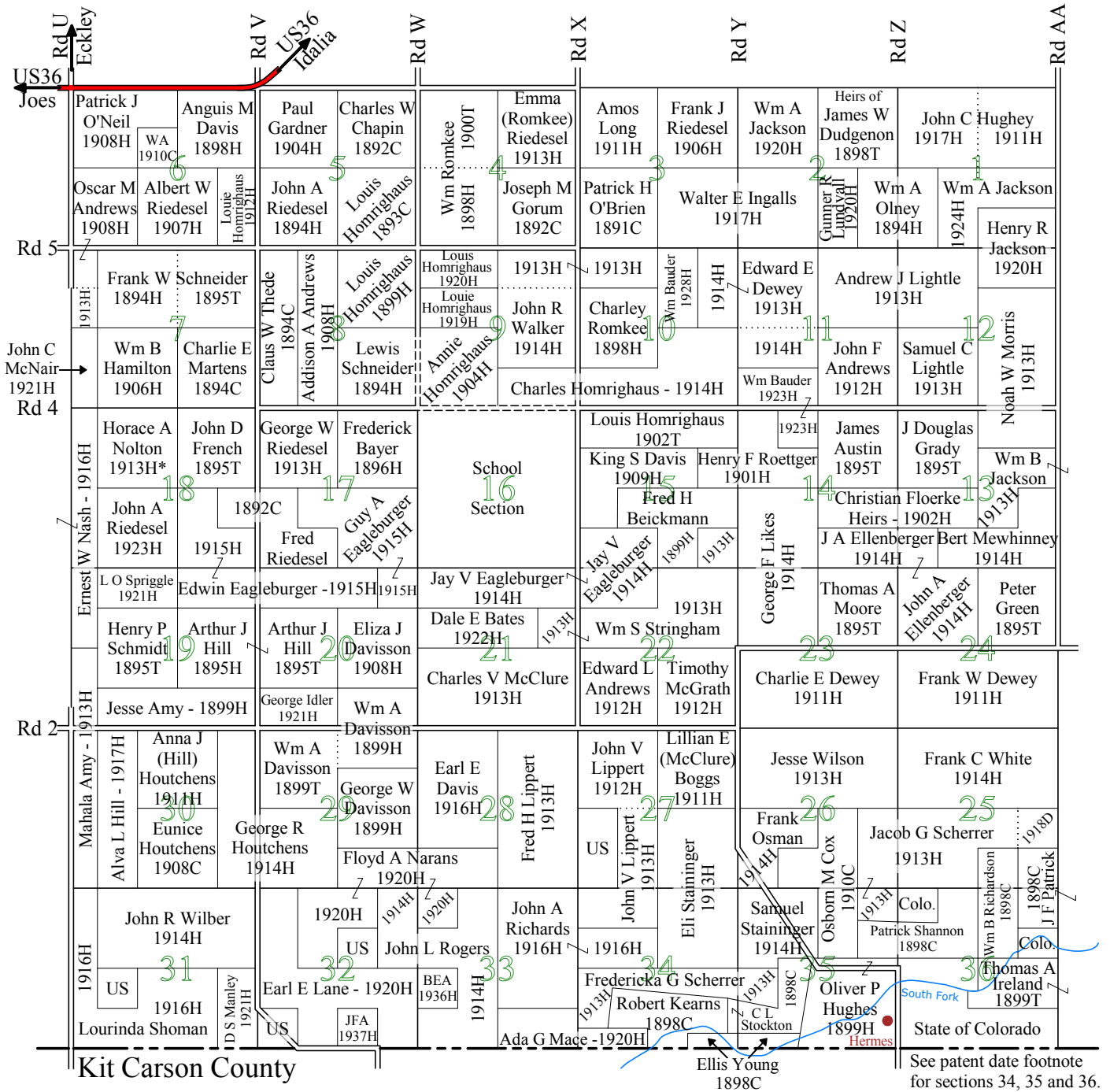


Township 5 South Range 45 West Yuma County, Colorado

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Notes:

The Hermes post office started in 1908 and closed in 1919.

The Horace Nolton 1913 patent was issued under the name "Holton". A corrected patent was issued in 1914.

The Emma (Romkee) Riedesel 1913 patent was issued with the spelling "Reidesel".

While the patents in sections 34, 35 and 36 are all dated 1898 or later they are the result of at least two GLO resurveys of the land along the South Fork of the Republican. Several of the patentees had much earlier patents that were cancelled and reissued:

Patrick Shannon 1893 patent, reissued 1898.

Charles Stockton 1885 patent, reissued in 1893 and 1898.

Ellis Young 1885 patent, reissued in 1893 and 1898.
